- **In E-poster** session abstract and E-poster submission deadline: 31 October 2019. Full paper submission deadline: 31 January 2020 (abstract up to 1,000 characters with spaces, full paper min. 6, max. 12 pages, in accordance with the formal requirements). E-poster submission deadline is 31 October 2019 (in accordance with the formal requirements).
- **As a visitor to the conference**, the registration is completed by filling in the registration form by 31 October 2019.

The reviewed material of the accepted scientific lectures will be published in the form of a stand-alone electronic publication with an ISBN number. The organizers reserve the right to reject the lectures based on the reviewers' opinions, to classify the lectures into sessions, and to reclassify the lectures in the E-poster session depending on the registered applications.
